By submitting this application, I affirm that the facts set forth in it are true and complete I also agree that:

- I will act in accordance with the Constitution and Policies and Procedures of RRANA. Moreover, I will act in accordance with the rules set out by National Parks and Wildlife Service guidelines and policies (NPWS).
- I will care for wildlife entrusted to me to the best of my ability with the goal of returning them to the wild in consultation with the species coordinator.
- I will be guided by the Wildlife Coordinators and Trainers in every aspect of the rescue and rehabilitation of wildlife entrusted to me and inform the relevant persons of animals in my care. I will also facilitate wherever possible open lines of communication with other members of the organisation.
- I will undertake training as required and will allow the relevant persons to inspect my premises at a mutually agreed time, if deemed necessary.
- I will be bound by the conditions of the Rehabilitation Licence issued by the Office of Environment and Heritage (NPWS).
- I will maintain accurate records about the wildlife in my care and update my records on a daily/weekly basis as required.
- I will present a report on the animals in my care at RRANA's monthly meeting. When this is not possible, I will inform a Wildlife Coordinator or an Office Bearer who will do so on my behalf.
- I will attend four (4) meeting per year. (Please see an Office Bearer to discuss exemption. Members who live more than 20kms from town are not required to attend four meeting per year but are encouraged to attend whenever possible).
- I agree that my labour is voluntary and that all activities carried out are at my own risk, and with no right of recourse against RRANA or any member of RRANA.
- I accept that membership of RRANA is dependent on payment of an annual membership fee (due each July).
- I understand that breaching these conditions may result in my suspension or expulsion from the organisation.
